RULES AND REGULATIONS

This Wisconsin Futurity Horse Festival and its Class Sponsors will not be responsible for any damages to persons, animals or property at the Show, nor shall they be liable for any accidents or injuries sustained by persons or animals on the show grounds at any time. Neither will they be responsible for any vehicle or any equipment which is lost or damaged.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and have him/her and his entire exhibit removed from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry.

Horses must be kept under control and if not, at the discretion of the judges, they may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees in this case.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE

All horses shipped into the State of Wisconsin must have the required health certificates, issued by a Veterinarian from the state of origin, available for inspection during the show. These must be in accordance with Wisconsin State Law.

POST ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE AUGUST 31st, 2009. ALL ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER AUGUST 31st SHALL BE ACCEPTED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS: A post entry fee of \$50/horse will be levied on all entries postmarked after August 31st, 2009 - **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it is subject to the rules and regulations of the Wisconsin Futurity Horse Show and the rules of USEF.

No entries will be admitted for exhibition until the entry blank is duly signed by the EXHIBITOR, TRAINER and OWNER.

POST DATED CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THERE WILL BE A \$25 FEE FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS. IF AN EXHIBITOR'S PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES HAS BEEN RETURNED NON-NEGOTIABLE IN THE PAST, THE COMPETITION HAS THE RIGHT TO REQUIRE THAT PERSON TO PAY AT ANY FURTHER COMPETITION WITH A CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. NO EXCEPTIONS! NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. The Show Committee reserves the right of declining to accept any entry or entries and to return any and all entrance fees. The Show Committee may also prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any owner or stable employee or horse from the ring or grounds without liability of any kind.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any classes, when there are less than five entries, the property of different owners, and to combine or divide any class or classes should such be in the best interest of the show.

REGISTRATION PAPERS USEF, ASHA, AHHS CARDS

A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership or Horse ID Registration for every entry MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY BLANK (Exceptions: Weanlings) ALONG WITH A PHOTOCOPY OF EVERY OWNER/TRAINER/RIDER USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND A PHOTOCOPY OF EVERY OWNER/TRAINER ASHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS, AHHS MEMBERSHIP CARDS, AND ARHPA CARD IF APPLICABLE. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE ASSESSED A \$15.00 PER ENTRY FEE.

REFUNDS

Exhibitors canceling their entries after August 31st shall forfeit their entry fee and stabling charge. During the course of the show entry fees may be refunded only if the horse scratched is examined by the Official Show Veterinarian and certified unable to show. No refunds will be made during the show. NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.

OPEN CHECKS

An open check is required to be left in the horse show office for each exhibitor participating in the horse show to cover any miscellaneous costs including, but not limited to, class additions, or additional stalls used. An open check left by a trainer covering all exhibitors he/she is responsible for will suffice for this requirement. No back numbers will be released until an open check is on file in the horse show office. If the open check is used for any additional fees, the amount of the check will be made available at the close of the horse show, or an exhibitor/trainer may pick up their unused open check at the close of the show. Horse show management has the right to wave this requirement as they feel is necessary.

OFFICE HOURS

Business hours will be from 8:30 A.M. until the last performance of the evening; however, the office will be closed **one hour prior** to each performance. All changes must be made before that time. Check posted office hours for any additional changes.

STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

A LISTING IN THE HORSE SHOW PROGRAM DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN ENTRY. ALL CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES MUST BE DECLARED AND PAID FOR IN THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THE HORSE WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW. THIS APPLIES TO STABLES WITH OPEN CHECKS.

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW IN A STAKE OR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS, A HORSE OR PONY MUST BE PROPERLY ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED IN A QUALIFYING CLASS IN THE SAME DIVISION. JACKPOT CLASSES DO NOT APPLY.

ENTRIES FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP & STAKE CLASSES, LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK, MUST BE MADE AND PAID FOR BEFORE 6:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, FOR SATURDAY NIGHT CLASSES. ENTRIES FOR SUNDAY AFTERNOON CLASSES MUST BE MADE AND PAID FOR BEFORE 10:00 A.M. SUNDAY MORNING. ENTRY FEES FOR ALL OTHER CLASSES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY BLANK, OR THE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED TO THE SENDER.

Exhibitors qualifying more than one horse may elect to show only one horse back without penalty. This does not apply to Wisconsin Futurity Classes.

If a Championship entry is paid by the deadline but is subsequently cancelled, no refunds will be given without an excuse from the official veterinarian.

SCRATCHES

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH EXHIBITOR TO OFFICIALLY SCRATCH ENTRIES IN ANY EVENT IN WHICH THEY DO NOT PARTICIPATE. THIS INCLUDES ALL STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES.

A \$25.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED FOR FAILURE TO SCRATCH AN ENTRY AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO SHOW TIME. IF A CLASS IS SUBSEQUENTLY DIVIDED, A \$100.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED.

DIVISION OF CLASSES

All pleasure driving classes will be divided at 15 or over. All other classes will be divided according to USEF rules. In a divided class, separate trophies and ribbons will be awarded. Notification of intent to divide will be made one hour prior to the start of the session. Grand National Classes will be governed by Grand National Rules. Futurity classes will be governed by Wisconsin Futurity rules.

OFFICIAL TIMER

The horse show Barn Announcer will be appointed as the “official timer” of the in gate.

JUDGING SYSTEM

The Majority Opinion Judging System (MOS) will be used to judge the horse show with the exception of the ASHA National Pleasure Equitation Championship. The guidelines and procedures regarding this judging system will be available in the horse show office.

The numerical judging system known as the SEN System will be used to judge the ASHA National Pleasure Equitation Championship. The guidelines and procedures regarding this judging system will be available in the horse show office.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Under no circumstances will substitutions of entries be permitted, except as provided by the USEF Rule Book.

PASSES

A \$15.00 EXHIBITOR DONOR BADGE is available for admittance to all performances and the exhibitor parties.

WARM-UP AREA/SHOW COLISEUM

The warm-up area will be in the Arena where footing consists of dirt and shavings. Arena is 85' x 200'. Competition will be in the coliseum where footing consists of dirt and shavings. Coliseum size is 100' x 215'. There will be bark footing along pathway from arena to coliseum.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are available for rental only to person(s) who reserve them prior to show. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards.

STABLING

ATTENTION

Stalls will be available on Monday, September 16th after 12:00 p.m.

STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW MANAGEMENT. Permanent box stalls with doors and tack stalls will be provided at a cost of \$115.00 per stall. All stall rent must be paid at time of entry. EACH HORSE ENTERED IN A CLASS MUST HAVE A STALL. (The only exceptions being: Broodmare &

Foal may share a stall). All tack stalls must be paid for in addition to the number of horses entered.

Please note: Shavings will be available on the grounds. Fiberboard is available. Quality Feed & Bedding 920-362-1040.

Any person altering in any way the stabling facilities provided by the management without express permission of the Show Manager or Grounds Manager may be evicted from the grounds for the duration of the show or fined \$100. Anyone found nailing tarps to barn will be billed for new tarps.

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

All connections must be approved by Alliant Energy Center officials and must meet state and national codes. The grounds manager will be advised of violations and will notify the offender. If corrections are not made, power will be disconnected to the individual exhibitor.

PARKING

Daily and weekly passes will be available at the gate. Parking of trailers, campers, etc., will be directed by the police department. Private vehicles will be required to have permits. A permit will be required to park a motor home on the grounds.

CONTACT WITH JUDGES

No exhibitor may confer with the Judges unless accompanied by the Show Steward.

WISCONSIN OWNED/SHOWN

In order to qualify for this class the registered owner and the exhibitor must be a Wisconsin resident at the time the class is held. A "Wisconsin resident" is a person who is registered to vote in Wisconsin or qualified to register to vote in Wisconsin, and who declares Wisconsin his/her state of residence for state and federal income tax purposes. If the registered owner is a minor, his/her custodial parent(s) must meet the above criteria. (The location where the horse is trained and/or boarded is immaterial.)

HOSPITALITY ROOMS

USE

MEMBERSHIP

STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a **\$30** nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. *EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08*

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The North Central American Saddlebred Regional Championships will take place at the Wisconsin Futurity Horse Festival. The North Central Region consists of the States of Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, North and South Dakota and Nebraska.

General Guidelines:

- Horses and equitation riders must compete and receive a ribbon (1 through 8) in three (3) separate competitions within the region, in the qualifying period, in the same section within the Saddlebred division, to qualify for a Regional Championship title in that region's championship event. Sections include Five-Gaited, Three-Gaited, Fine Harness, Park, Park Pleasure, Show Pleasure, and Country Pleasure, Saddle Seat Equitation, etc.
- The highest placing, qualified horse or equitation rider in a Regional Championship class shall be named Regional Champion, receive an exclusive tri-color and neck ribbon, and make a victory pass.
- For the 2009 year, the qualifying period is from the day following the ending date of the Regional Championship horse show in 2008 to the day prior to the starting date for the Regional Championship show in 2009.
- Qualifying shows need not be USEF-licensed but must be recorded in the ASHA database of competitions, and ASHA must receive official results. Regional Championship competitions themselves do not count as qualifying shows, unless the competition was not designated as a Regional Championship in the prior year. For example, the 2009 ASHAV Horse Show is designated as the Region 11 championship for the first time in 2009. The 2008 ASHAV Horse Show counts for qualifying for 2009. The 2009 ASHAV Horse Show will not count for qualifying if ASHAV is the Region 11 championship in 2010. Conversely, Penn National was the 2008 Region 11 championship. Because it is not the 2009 Regional Championship, the 2008 Penn National will count as a qualifying show in Region 11 for 2009.
- In the case of a sale of a horse, all qualifying records will travel with the horse (equitation excepted).
- Horses/equitation riders may earn only one Regional Championship title in a given calendar year. Once a horse wins a Regional Championship title, it is no longer eligible for additional titles even if it is qualified and competes at subsequent Regional Championship competitions. Conversely, if a horse competes in a Regional Championship class and does not win the Regional Championship title, it may compete for a Regional Championship title at other Regional Championship competitions for which it is eligible. Declaration of region is not required in 2009.

AMATEUR CARD

ALL AMATEURS, over age 18, must have available for inspection, a current USEF AMATEUR CARD or make proper application at the show office one hour prior to class. Certification must be renewed annually.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS: The UPHA Classics may be offered for Three-Year-Olds and Under for the American Saddlebred and Morgan Horse divisions, and Four-Year-Olds and Under for the Hackney Pony divisions.

In order to show in a UPHA Classic, all horses and ponies must be registered with their appropriate breed registry and **MUST** be shown under their registered name.

UPHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: The professional trainer of a UPHA Classic entry must be an Active member of the UPHA in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank. If a non-professional is exhibiting the horse, they must be an Associate or Junior member of the UPHA, in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank.

RULES FOR ENTERING: A non-refundable Eligibility Fee of \$50 paid to the UPHA Office postmarked on or before April 1st of each year. After April 1st, the Eligibility Fee becomes \$100 per horse. Payment of the Eligibility Fee will be made in the name of the entered horse or pony and will make that animal eligible to compete in any and all UPHA Classics classes held that year. Eligibility remains with the animal throughout the year should transfer of ownership occur. Eligibility Fees collected will be used as prize money in the UPHA Classic Grand Championships. All Eligibility Fees collected within a breed will be used in that breed's championship classes.

The entry fee for each qualifying class is \$100 and is made in two payments. The first payment, the Declaration Fee, is \$50 and must be made by the entry closing date of the particular horse show. The second payment, the Starting Fee, is also \$50 and is due 24 hours prior to the class, whenever practical. All entry fees, or partial entry fees, are added to the total purse of the class.

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION: All monies collected in each Classic will be dispersed in that class. Prize money in a \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic is divided as follows: \$300 is deducted from the total, with \$100 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the total prize money the original percentages would apply, without the \$300 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total.

Prize money in a \$250 Added Money Classic would be broken down in the same percentages as the other UPHA Classic classes, however, only \$50 would be awarded to the fourth, fifth and sixth places.

UPHA CLASSIC GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS: UPHA Classic Grand Championships will be offered for Three-Year-Olds and Under for the American Saddlebred and Morgan Horse divisions, and Four-Year-Olds and Under for the Hackney Pony divisions. Added Money in the UPHA Classic Grand Championships is \$12,000 in all Saddlebred and Hackney Pony divisions, and \$5,000 in the Morgan divisions. All entry fees collected for the UPHA Classic Grand Championships will be added to the purse of each Championship.

To be Eligible for competition in any UPHA Classic Grand Championship, a horse or pony must have place first through sixth in any UPHA Classic qualifying class, and both the owner and trainer of the entry must be an Active or Associate member of the UPHA.

4. Documentation has been submitted to the horse show that the rider has shown in at least two pleasure equitation classes during a given competition season.
5. Only classes held at a USEF rated show will count towards qualification.
6. It is the responsibility of the owner, trainer or agent to provide verification of the shows in which the entry has qualified. \$5000 Scholarship (\$1000 donated by Knollwood Knockouts)

The use of artificial appliances or devices on weanlings and yearlings such as chains, shackles, rubber bands or blindfolds is PROHIBITED on the show grounds before or during a show. Smooth, round leather straps are ALLOWED.

Blinker hoods with half-cups mounted in the vertical position so as to allow forward vision are ALLOWED on weanlings and yearlings on the grounds before or during a show. Weanlings and yearlings must show with uncut, unset tails: tail sets or bustles worn on the show grounds or in preparation for the show are expressly PROHIBITED.

Use of curb bits on weanlings and yearlings is PROHIBITED. Any entry with PROHIBITED equipment must be disqualified from further competition and shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings. All nominated foals must be registered American Saddlebreds. Back numbers will not be released until copies of registration papers are on file in the horse show office.

ASHB FUTURITY OF WISCONSIN OPEN FUTURITY NOMINATED DIVISION

Classes in this division must be Open Futurity Nominated and are governed by the rules of the Wisconsin Futurity.

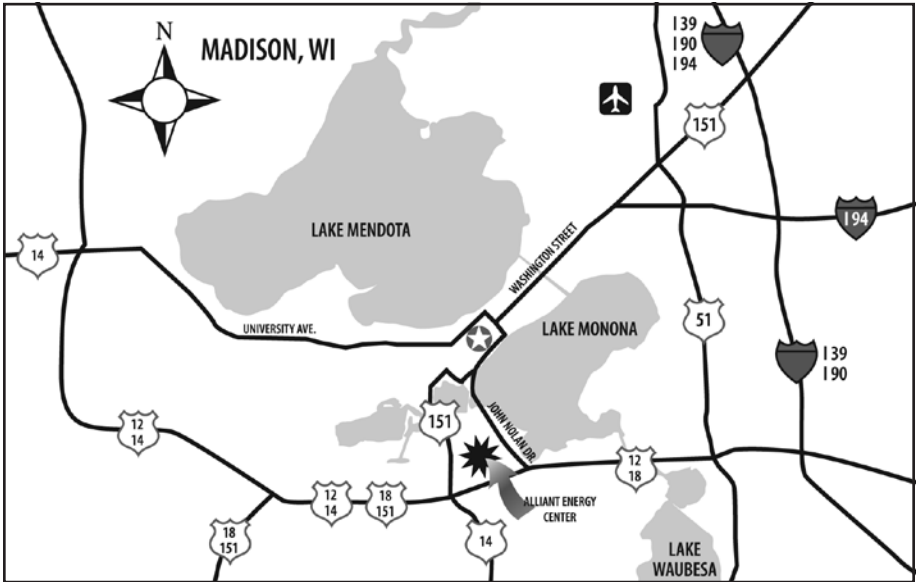
